OVERVIEW

SV Partners was appointed as the voluntary administrator of Isa Rodeo Limited on 21 October 2024 and will oversee the company's operations during this period.

While 2024 did not meet attendance and financial expectations, the rodeo is a longstanding event that has been a significant economic driver for the Mount Isa and North West Queensland, supporting local businesses and bringing in significant revenue.

There is opportunity to leverage the unique event portfolio and deliver a successful Mount Isa Rodeo in 2025 and beyond.

The sport of rodeo, which includes the Indigenous Rodeo Championships, is at the heart of the event and celebrates a unique program of art, music, food, and culture.

Without the rodeo, the region risks losing a culturally significant event and major economic anchor.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to identify potential event delivery partners and sponsors to be involved in a strong plan to reinvigorate the event, deliver returns, not just for the rodeo but for the entire region through sustained tourism and economic activity.

The EOI period is open from 1 November to 15 November 2024.

Some things to consider when submitting an Expression of Interest may include if the individual/business:

- promotes core values which align with those of the major event and City of Mount Isa and North West Queensland
- has a brand that positively aligns with the region and the Mount Isa Rodeo
- will provide benefit to the event in addition to the existing program.

THE OPPORTUNITY

The Mount Isa Mines Indigenous Rodeo Championships is a stand-alone event that showcases the amazing talents of Indigenous Rodeo competitors and gives visibility to the stories of Australia's Indigenous Stockmen and Stockwomen.

You can be part of reinvigorating the Rodeo that helps generate new economic activity and raises the profile of Mount Isa and Outback Queensland as the "Rodeo Capital of Australia".

THE ADMINISTRATORS' PROPOSAL FOR RENEWAL

The Mount Isa Rodeo is an iconic community event that for the past 65 years, has been delivered by a community focused entity.

This has evolved from its initial informal structure to the Mount Isa Rotary Rodeo Inc., and now via Isa Rodeo Ltd (the Company).

The opportunity now exists for the Company to renew its governance and business model to realign with its community roots.

TRANSITION TO THE FUTURE

Since 2021, the Company has been responsible for the operational delivery of the week-long Mount Isa Rodeo.

To move forward, it is proposed the Company and the Board shift focus from the operational delivery to oversight of events provided by individual delivery partners.

By undertaking this pivot, it allows the Company to partner with community service organisations, the Mount Isa City Council and specialist delivery partners, who can focus on the operational delivery of key events.

The diagram below outlines the proposed operating structure.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

For the 2025 event to proceed, it's important to gain an understanding of how the event portfolio will be delivered.

The first step is to identify potential delivery partners, sponsors and alliances.

. DELIVERY PARTNER

SV Partners is seeking Expressions of Interest from interested parties that want to take on responsibility of planning, managing, and delivering a number of the important events that occur during the rodeo.

Either as an individual, business, or community group, please nominate your interest in being a delivery partner for one or a number of the following events.

The delivery partner will bring expertise, resources, and support to the role. They will take responsibility for a wide range of services and may include logistics, staffing, equipment setup, technical support, and marketing.

2. SPONSORSHIP

Event sponsorship is a partnership where a company or organisation provides financial support, products, or services to an event in exchange for brand exposure and promotional opportunities.

Sponsorship has always been an important part of being able to successfully deliver the Mount Isa Rodeo.

In the past key sponsors have included Glencore, Bell & Moir Toyota, Ariat, and XXXX.

SV Partners is seeking expressions of interest from businesses of all sizes that may want to sponsor the 2025 event.



3. LONG-TERM PARTNERSHIP

A long-term partnership is a commitment between two organisations to collaborate and achieve mutual goals.

The Mount Isa Rodeo attracts more than 25,000 attendees, and millions of dollars of spend in the City of Mount Isa and Queensland. Long-term partners recognise the value this event brings to the community, and provide financial support and resources in return.

Mount Isa City Council has been a long-term partner and proud supporter of the rodeo for decades, recognising the mutual value creation.

Tourism and Events Queensland has been a long-term partner and see the significance of the Mount Isa Rodeo, driving the growth of the visitor economy in Outback Queensland.

SV Partners is seeking expressions of interest from long-term partners to make a commitment to 2025 and beyond.

4. BOARD RENEWAL

The existing Board members will be stepping down from their roles and SV Partners are calling for suitably qualified people to fill a Board role as a representative of the Mount Isa Community.

The suggested new Board structure is as follows:

- 5 Community Representatives
- 1 Representative from the Mount Isa City Council
- 1 Representative appointed by the Minister for Tourism; and
- 1 Representative appointed by the Naming Rights Sponsor.

Subject to the approval of creditors, the Constitution of the Company will be amended to embed the above structure, the requirement for a rolling Director renewal process, and independent appointment committee for future director appointments.

MOUNT ISA RODEO

LEGENDARY SINCE 1959

In 1959, a group of people with passion and an intrinsic sense of potential formed the Mount Isa Rodeo.

Their vision was to put the new, remote town of Mount Isa on the map and raise funds for charity organisations in the new city. Through 60 years of whip-cracking vision and dedication, the Rodeo evolved into an event of legendary status.

BIG SPENDERS

Rodeo visitors are repeat attendees and big spenders.

- Over 40.4% are first timers, with a strong base of repeat visitors
- Nearly a quarter of visitors estimate spending more than \$2,000 while in Mount Isa
- 44% stayed 3-4 days
- Total spend by all attendees in Queensland \$11.13m
- Total spend by attendees in Mount Isa region \$7.73m


